We may collect email addresses and other personally identifiable data about visitors when such data is voluntarily submitted to us for information or registration purposes. We use industry standard data collection methodologies to securely collect and transmit your sensitive information.

Some information on our participant lists, such as names, email addresses, addresses, and phone numbers may be exchanged with partners and other organizations with principles or missions that overlap ours. Supporters may opt out of such supporter list exchanges at any time. Our purpose is to protect your information while making sure you have what you need to make an informed decision as a voter and citizen. If you have ever voluntarily provided your contact information to us and want to look at, change, or remove the information we have on record, you may contact us via email at info@championthevote.com.

After you provide voter registration information to local or state election officials, it generally becomes a matter of public record from your state of residence. This means it will be available for inspection and use by candidates for public office and their campaign organizations as well as by others who satisfy the requirements of the State law governing its use.
